

CHLORAMPHENICOL EYE OINTMENT

Composition:

Each 1g contains: 20 mg Chloramphenicol and 15 000 I.U. Vitamin A

General information:

Chloramphenicol is a broadspectrum antibiotic which acts by interfering with bacterial protein synthesis. It is usually bacteriostatic and is effective against a wide range of Gram-negative and Gram-positive bacteria.

Chloramphenicol penetrates rapidly into the cell membrane. The ointment is not only suitable for surface treatments, but also for infections in the eyeball.

Vitamin A contributes to maintaining the epithelium of the cornea.

Indications:

Conjunctivitis, keratitis, blennorrhoea, ulcus corneae.

Dosage:

For the first application, apply approximately 1 g ointment to the eyeball: thereafter treat everyday with a small quantity.

Storage:

store at room temperature.

Stability:

3 years.

Presentation:

4 g tubes containing ointment
