

MECLOMA 5 mg/ml

Composition:

Each ml solution contains 5 mg Metoclopramide hydrochloride

Action:

Mecloma has a dual mode of action. It possesses parasympathomimetic activity and thereby increases the motility of the upper gastro-intestinal tract without affecting gastric acid secretion. It increases gastric peristalsis leading to accelerated gastric emptying. Mecloma is also a dopamine receptor antagonist with a direct depressant effect on the chemoreceptor trigger zone. It is used to reduce vomiting in gastritis and following surgery, and in the treatment of ruminal atony or oesophageal reflux. It is of little benefit in prevention of motion sickness in dogs and cats. Mecloma may cause restlessness and excitement in some dogs.

Indications:

Gastrointestinal diseases, postoperative vomiting where sedation is not required in dogs and cats.

Administration:

Mecloma should be administered by intramuscular injection using normal aseptic techniques

Dosage:

cat, dog: 0.5 - 1 mg/kg bodyweight daily over 3 -4 times, by intramuscular or intravenous injection.

Storage:

Cool (+8 / +15°C) and protected from light.

Presentation:

10 ml bottle
